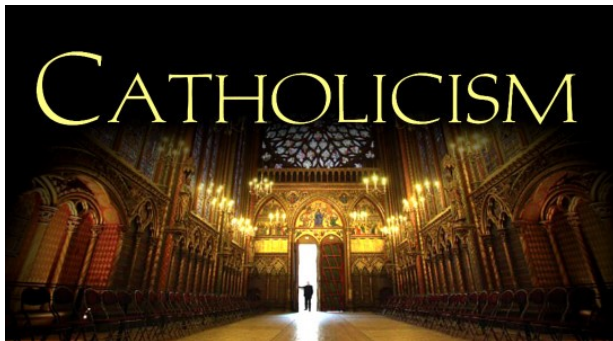

Feast of the Ascension May 28, 2017



Session 1: Amazed and Afraid.
